Inter County Ticket Policy

Introduction

As a unit of Cumann Lúthchleas Gael, CLG na nDúnaibh are allocated a finite number of tickets for some inter-county matches. This allocation of tickets does not always meet demand, and the club executive have adopted this policy to determine how tickets are to be distributed.

Membership

Club membership is very important each year and non-members will not be considered for tickets for any inter-county games at the expense of club members. Closing date for full membership in any given year is 31st March.

Being a member of the club does not automatically entitle an individual to a ticket for an inter-county match. To be part of a club involves working in all aspects of the club, to assist in the running of the club and ensuring the club makes progress. This policy is designed to reward active members who contribute to the objectives of CLG na nDúnaibh.

Distribution of tickets

The following criteria for the distribution of tickets for inter-county matches will apply at the discretion of the committee. Tickets will be allocated to club members on a descending points basis. Points will be allocated to members on a sliding basis:

Club Officers and committee members	6 points
Players & Referees	5 points
Mentors	4 points
Workers	4 points
Bingo helpers	4 points
Gate persons	4 points
Lotto workers and lotto sellers	4 points
Full adult member	2 points
Social member	1 point

Underage members

In the event that Donegal are playing in a Senior or Minor All Ireland final, at least 10% of the club's ticket allocation will be allocated to youth members, to be distributed at the discretion of the minor board. The remainder will be allocated based on the policy described above.
